

Guide to the Extraordinary Cash Payment for School Supplies

- ◆ The Shinjuku City Board of Education is providing an extraordinary cash payment (**20,000 yen per child**) for school supplies for school-age children as an emergency measure against rising prices, etc.
- ◆ **You may have to take steps** in order to receive the payment.
- ◆ For details, check the guidance planned to be mailed on **December 26 (Mon.)**.



Payment eligibility and procedure (flow chart)

(1) You have a child born between April 2, 2007 and April 1, 2016



(2) The child is a registered resident of Shinjuku City as of December 9, 2022 (cut-off date) *

The child is not eligible.



(3) You are currently receiving the child allowance from Shinjuku City for the child



(4) **Steps are required.**



(4) The transfer is planned to be made to the account that receives the child allowance on January 31, 2023 (Tues.).
No steps are required.

◆ Procedure

- ✓ Fill out the confirmation sheet enclosed with the guidance, attach the required documents, enclose them in the return envelope, and submit it by **mail**.

◆ Submission deadline for confirmation sheet

Postmarked by February 28, 2023 (Tues.)

◆ Planned transfer date

- ✓ You will be informed of the planned transfer date through separate guidance on the payment.
