Emergency Bag List




An **emergency bag** is a bag that contains the minimum essentials needed for the time being after you evacuate.

In preparing an **emergency bag**, it is important to think about what each of you would need, and select items to be put in the bag. Pack those items in bags such as knapsacks, and place them near the front entrance or in the bedroom, car, or shed so that you can carry them out even if your house has collapsed.
