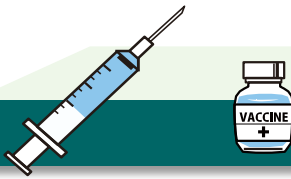


Notice of COVID-19 vaccination



[Sending to residents aged 75 and above as of March 31, 2022]

Please find enclosed your COVID-19 vaccination tickets (vouchers).
If you wish to be vaccinated, please make an appointment as follows.
Vaccination is available free of charge (at public expense).



1 Appointment for Vaccination

An appointment is required to receive vaccination.

Appointments will be accepted from **10:00 a.m. on May 6, 2021.**

Appointments for Group Vaccination Sites

▶ Appointment by phone

Please call after 10:00 a.m. on May 6 and press the appropriate number according to the voice guidance.

* The number for appointments is "1."

▶ Appointment through website

A website to book appointments is being planned.

Appointments will be accepted from 10:00 a.m. on May 6.

▶ Details will be announced in the **special edition of Koho Shinjuku (Shinjuku bulletin) (issued on May 1), on the Shinjuku City website, etc.**

* Faxes will be accepted from people who are hearing impaired and cannot use the phone.

2 Vaccination Sites and Date/Time

Community centers, Genkikan, hospitals, etc. are planned to become vaccination sites, but it may be difficult to vaccinate everyone at once at every site depending on the vaccine supply.

Details on the vaccination sites and date/time will be notified in the **special edition of Koho Shinjuku (Shinjuku bulletin) (issued on May 1), on the Shinjuku City website, etc.**

* Unless you are hospitalized or admitted to a facility, you can be vaccinated in the municipality (place of residence) where your residency is registered.

Precautions for the Day of Your Appointment

On the day of your appointment, please bring the following items and come to the site you reserved.

Items to bring on the day

- **Vaccination ticket** (Enclosed with this notice. Please bring **without removing** the sticker.)
- **Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire** (Enclosed for two doses. Please **fill in one copy** and bring it with you.)
- **Identification document** (Driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)

*Please measure your body temperature at home on the day, and refrain from being vaccinated if you have a fever or do not feel well and contact the medical institution where you made the appointment or the Shinjuku City call center.

*Please wear **clothes that make it easy to access your shoulders.**

To receive the full effect of the vaccine, the **same type** of vaccine must be administered **twice**. After the first vaccination, please receive your second vaccination after **3 weeks**. (If more than 3 weeks have elapsed after the first vaccination, please receive the second vaccination as soon as possible.)

* Appointments for the second vaccination can be made after the first vaccination.



◎ Your consent is required to receive the vaccine

If you are currently undergoing treatment for a disease or have concerns about your health condition, please consult with your family doctor before deciding whether or not to receive the vaccine.

◎ Vaccination at places other than the place where the resident card is registered (place of residence)

- If you are receiving the vaccine at a medical institution where you are being hospitalized or treated, or at a facility where you are admitted → Please consult with the hospital or facility.
- If your residence is different from your address → You may be able to receive the vaccine in the area where you actually live.

Please contact the Shinjuku City call center or the consultation office of the municipality in which you actually live.
