Plastic Recycling Rules will be changed

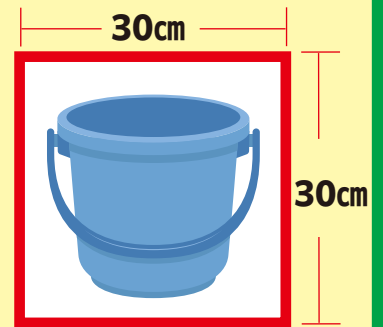
~Plastic Products will be classified as Recyclable Resources~

"Plastic Products" that have collected as "Combustible Garbage" will be collected together with "Plastic Containers and Packaging Materials" as Recyclable Resources.

◆Plastics that are recyclable resources

In addition to "Plastic Containers and Packaging Materials" that are marked with "Plastic" logos, "Plastic Products" * will be classified as Recyclable Resources.

*Only 100% plastic (single-material-plastic) that are less than 5 mm thick and no more than 30 cm in any dimensions. .

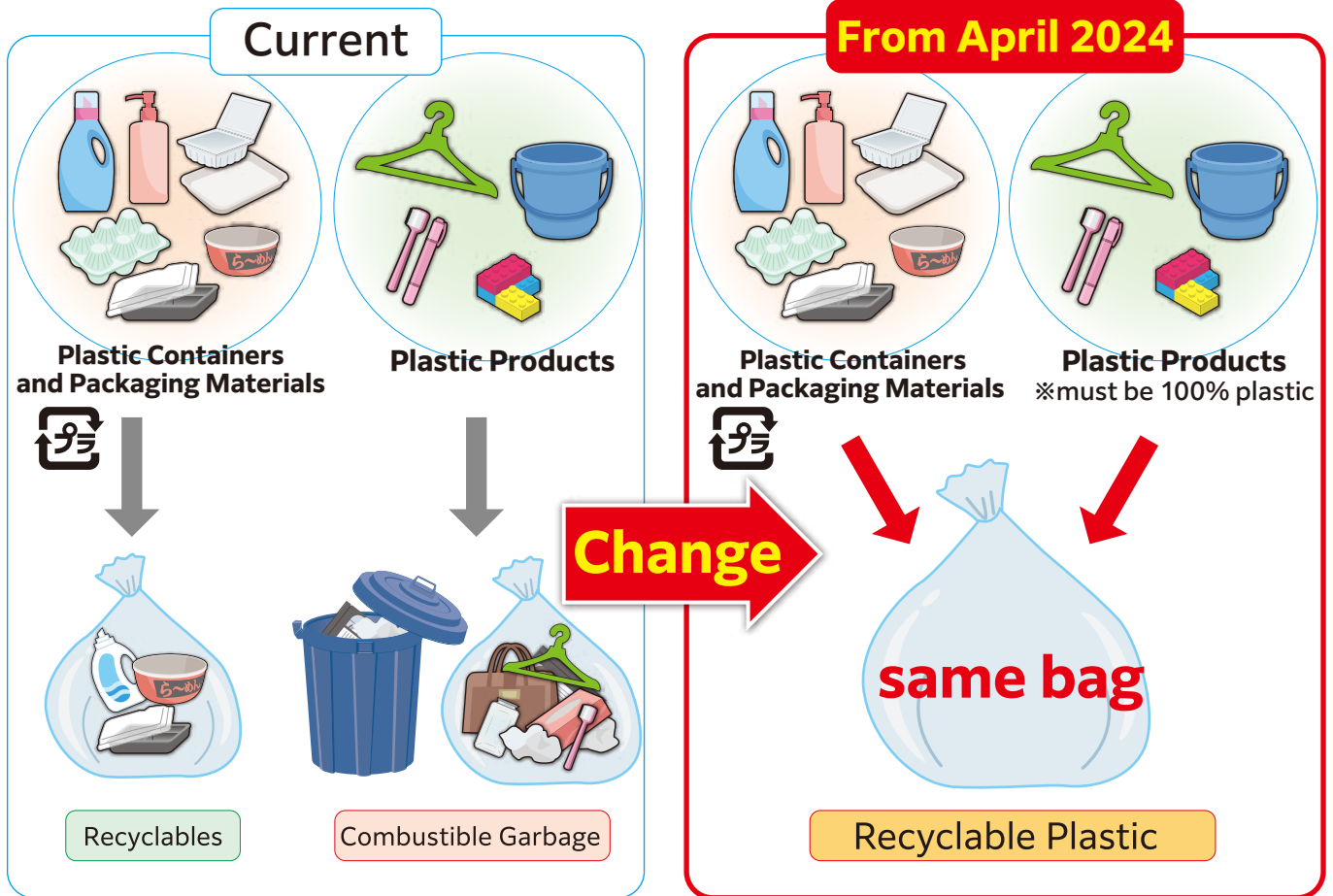
Examples of Plastic Products (single-material-plastic)



◆ Way to dispose of

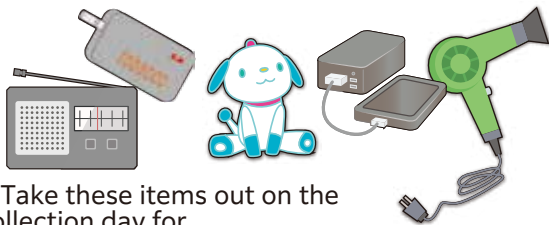
Please combine **"Plastic Containers and Packaging Materials"** and **"Plastic Products"** in one bag.
 Take them out to your designated recyclables/waste collection point once a week
 on the recyclables collection day.

There will be no change in the recyclables collection schedule



Items cannot be collected as Recyclables

Items with built-in small rechargeable batteries.
 Items that run on electricity or batteries.



→Take these items out on the collection day for Metal/Ceramic/Glass Garbage.

Items that contain materials other than plastic such as metal.



→Take these items out on the collection day for Metal/Ceramic/Glass Garbage.

Syringes used for home medical care.



Containers with residual contents, those that are extremely dirty, or those that exceed 30cm cannot be collected.

※Items with built-in small rechargeable batteries and lighters that may cause a fire hazard are not recyclable plastics.
