Plastic is a resource


From April 2024 onward, product plastics, which were previously collected as burnable waste, will be collected and recycled alongside packaging plastics as resource plastics.

Items that can be collected as recyclable plastic



Product plastic

Made of 100% plastic and generally with dimensions not exceeding 30 cm square.









Packaging plastic



Plastic containers and packaging marked with the symbol for plastic, which are no longer needed after the contents have been used.















How to dispose of plastic resources



Please put "product plastic" and "packaging plastic" in a single bag and take it to the resource/garbage collection point on your designated day once a week.



Items that cannot be collected as resources

Note: For items exceeding 30 cm in any dimension, please apply for disposal as oversized waste.







Items containing materials other than plastic, such as metal



Caution: Lithium-ion batteries and other small rechargeable batteries can cause fires.

Please take small rechargeable batteries and power banks to JBRC cooperative stores (such as electronics retailers). For products with non-removable small rechargeable batteries, please dispose of them as metal, ceramic, or glass waste.
